Percentage Bequest

"I give to the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation, 301 N. Main Street, Suite 300, Ann Arbor, MI 48104, Michigan nonprofit corporation, or its successor, Federal Tax Identification Number: 38-6087967, ____% of my residuary estate to be added to the Ann Arbor Hands-On Museum Endowment Fund."

Residuary Bequest
