

- 1 Leslie House & Main Office— The main office is open M-F.
- 2 **Raptor Enclosures** These live birds of prey are no longer able to survive in the wild on their own. They now serve as wildlife ambassadors.
- 3 **Critter House** Home for many animals used to educate and inspire respect for our natural world. The Critter House is open most Sundays, 12-3p.m.
